

## **Permitted/Prohibited Political Activities for Members of OkACTE While Off-Duty**

### **Members may:**

- Be candidates for public office in partisan elections.
- Register and vote as they choose.
- Assist in voter registration drives.
- Express opinions about candidates and issues.
- Contribute money to political organizations.
- Attend political fundraising functions.
- Attend and be active at political rallies and meetings.
- Join and be an active member of a political party.
- Sign nominating petitions.
- Campaign for or against referendum questions, constitutional amendments, and/or municipal ordinances.
- Campaign for or against candidates in partisan elections.
- Make campaign speeches for candidates in partisan elections.
- Distribute campaign literature in partisan elections outside of school property.
- Hold office in political clubs or parties.

### **Members may not:**

- Use official authority/influence to interfere with an election.
- Engage in political activity while: on duty, using a state or school vehicle or equipment.
- Wear partisan political buttons on duty.
