Out of those 2442 calls, 378 (15%) of those followed up with services.



Pursuing the Following Grants for 2023-2024:


First Grant Building Capacity for Human Trafficking Victims

This federal grant is \$110,000, the match is \$27,500.00. This can be a donation match or an in-kind donation, which can be equipment, land, or services donated.

Transitional Housing Grant

This federal grant is \$150,000 with a match of \$37,500. This can be donations or in-kind donations which consists of land donation, labor, or any services donated.
